## IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT YOUR DRINKING WATER

Sebewaing Light and Water (SLW) is required by the State of Michigan to monitor your drinking water for specific contaminants on a regular basis. These results are an indicator of whether or not our drinking water meets the current health standards. In 2024, from January 1 to September 30, the Radium 226 & 228 sample along with testing needed to be completed. SLW was notified of the missed test and completed the testing of Radium 226 & 228 on October 23, 2024. The test for Radium 226 & 228 passed. The State issued a violation due to the missed test deadline, however, this violation **does not** pose a threat to your water supply.

What should I do? As a community water supplier, we want to keep you informed of this situation and our corrective action. There is nothing you need to do at this time, and this situation is not an emergency.

The table below shows the missed contaminants, the frequency of the required test, the number of tests required and the time when the test should have been taken. We did this testing on October 23, 2024.

What happened? What is being done? In 2024, we sampled all required contaminants highlighted but inadvertently missed the Radium 226/228 test. In an effort to correct this situation, our annual compliance requirements will be reviewed by at least two qualified water operators, including the Operator in Charge.
